OPPORTUNITIES FOR SERVICE

Our Parish program depends on volunteers who give of themselves and so witness by deeds of service to the Way of the Lord Jesus. Please consider assisting the Religious Education Program as a Catechist, Aide, Hall Monitor or Substitute:

CATECHIST (Pre-K – 6)

Qualifications: A love for and practice of the Catholic Faith, and a desire to share the faith with our young people; patience and understanding; willingness to grow in faith and knowledge.

Responsibilities: Arrive several minutes before Mass and check in with the Coordinator. Pray for the children, their families, and each other; arrive several minutes before Mass; prepare and lead lessons according to the Parish Religious Education mission, goals, and vision. Notify the Coordinator in advance (if possible) of the need for a substitute. Report any concerns to the Coordinator.

CLASSROOM AIDE; HALL MONITOR; SUBSTITUTE

Qualifications: Patience and understanding; willingness to grow in faith and knowledge.

Responsibilities: Pray for the children, families, and each other; monitor the students going to the rest rooms, support teachers and coordinator where help is needed, keep track of the time, and help lead the students up to Mass after a session is completed.

It is the policy of the Diocese of Manchester that ALL Catechists, Aides, Hall Monitors and Substitutes must complete an application form and undergo a criminal background check with the State of NH before they are allowed to participate in the Religious Education Program. Additionally, all Parish Volunteers must complete "Safe Haven" on line training. Please see the Religious Education Coordinator with any questions.
